1. Decision Points — When We Leave

These are the triggers that tell our household it's time to evacuate.

We will leave if:

- We receive an official evacuation notice
- We see visible danger (smoke, fire, rising water, chemical odor)
- Power is out during extreme heat or cold
- Roads begin to close or conditions worsen
- We cannot confirm everyone's safety
- Our instincts say it's safer to go
